**PARENT/GUARIAN/ASSOCIATION AGREEMENT**

**BOBCATS REQUEST POLICY:** The Tinley Park Bobcats attempt to honor requests whenever possible at all age levels. However, for the older divisions, the Bobcats use a "ratings" system as an attempt to balance teams within each division. In all cases, the "ratings" of perspective players will take precedence over special requests for player assignments to teams. The only exception to this rule is regarding siblings. All siblings playing within the same division will be placed on the same team unless specifically requested not to do so. **PLEASE UNDERSTAND THAT A REQUEST IS JUST THAT, A REQUEST, AND NOT A GUARANTEE.** You should make sure that your child(ren) still wish to register given the possibility that a special request may not be honored.

Soccer Coach's are randomly chosen and once chosen are allowed a total including their own child(ren) 4 requests where another player has requested their child(ren). After the fourth request everyone will be placed into lottery system in order to achieve a balance of age and skill level to make the season fun for all. Commissioners will be assigning teams.

**Mandatory Participation:** I understand and agree that in registering my child(ren) in the Tinley Park Bobcats programs, I will insure the sale/purchase of Association-approved and distributed candy for the sole intent and purpose of raising funds for the Association. **Waiver:** I understand that I may elect to pay an additional \$30.00 at the time of registration and, in doing so; my required participation in the candy sale is waived.

**Baseball/Soft Mandatory Participation:** I understand and agree that in registering my child(ren) in the Tinley Park Bobcats Baseball/Softball, I will insure my family will volunteer for 4 hours working in the concession stand per child that play at Bettenhausen Park and the sole intent of volunteering for this position is to keep cost down and raising funds for the Association. **Waiver:** I understand that I may elect to pay an additional \$50.00 per child (up to 3 children) who plays at Bettenhausen Park at the time of registration and, in doing so; my required participation in the concession stand is waived.

**BOBCATS CODE OF CONDUCT:** The primary objective of the Tinley Park Bobcats youth organization is to provide positive experiences and "organized fun" for the youth of our community through sports/activities. The Bobcat policy has always been "FUN FIRST, WINNING SECOND".

Recently, and sadly, youth organizations across the country (including the Bobcats) have seen a dramatic rise in unacceptable conduct – not by the children participating in the sport/activity – but by adult coaches and spectators (i.e., parents, grandparents, etc.). Unfortunately, the Bobcats have had to adopt a formal "Code of Conduct" that all coaches and parents must agree to abide by prior to the Bobcat's accepting registration of their children for a sport/activity. Specifically:

- Coaches/Parents are not permitted to intimidate/argue with game officials (umpires, referees, etc.).
- Use of alcohol, drugs, and profanity are not allowed on any of the fields/facilities during Bobcats youth activities.
- Behavior that is inappropriate or detracting from the positive experience that the Bobcats must strive to provide our children will not be tolerated.

Understanding that any coach/parent in violation of this conduct policy will be subject to:

- Coach – termination of coaching privileges for the immediate season and/or possibly several/indefinite seasons (including other Bobcat sports).
- Parent – will not be allowed at any Bobcat game/event for the remainder of the season and, if the violation warrants such action, their child will be ejected from the program for the remainder of the season without a refund.

Hopefully ALL Bobcat parents will adhere to this conduct policy and youth sports can return to an enjoyable, respectable, and positive event in which our children not only learn a sport but actually have fun while doing so.

**REGISTRATION DEADLINE & REFUND POLICY**

The deadline for walk-up registration is February 6, 2012. A late fee of \$40 and the \$30 candy buy-out will be assessed for any registration form received between February 6, 2012, and February 19, 2012. **No registration forms will be accepted after February 19, 2011 - THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS.**

The deadline for refund requests is the first of the month at the start of program practices. **Therefore, March 1, 2012, is the deadline for refund requests.** All requests for refunds must be submitted in writing to the Tinley Park Bobcats, P.O. Box 488, Tinley Park, IL 60477 and postmarked on or before March 1, 2012. No late fees will be refunded. After March 1, 2012, refunds will only be issued for medical or relocation reasons. There will be a \$20 processing fee assessed on all refunds.
