FUNDRAISER: The fundraiser is in an effort to better our diamonds and make the field safer place for your children to play. The raffle tickets also give you an opportunity to win BIG.

FIELD LOCATION: Please speak with your Manager about field location and include maps/directions for your families.

PARKING: Parking is allowed in designated areas only. Please respect handicapped parking areas. Violators will be ticketed.

SPECTATOR SEATING: At all games, the teams will always be in the appointed dug out and parents and spectators should remain in the bleachers or seats away from dug out.

SPECTATOR CONDUCT A few reminders to all:

- Spectators need to be there to cheer the players on and to show support.
- Poor sportsmanship will not be tolerated.
- The use of profanity, tobacco products or alcoholic beverages by anyone is not permitted. This policy applies to both practices and games.
- Our umpires are not to be harassed.
- Linesmen are not provided; spectators may be asked to fill this position.
- Children playing on the sidelines should be at a safe distance from the fields. Ball playing especially should be done away from the fields and spectators.
- The fields and spectator areas are to be free of garbage after the game(s).

CONCESSION STAND: Each team that plays at Bettenhausen Park (Baseball = Shetland, Pinto, Mustang & Bronco & Softball = Pixie T's, Barrettes, Ponytail, Powder and Diamond). All teams are required to get parents (who did not pay the Buy Out) or anyone over the age of 16 to volunteer for 3 hours during the season. Sign up information will follow game schedules.
